Instructions

Delaware Law, Sections 5121, states that "Every railroad company, suburban or interurban railroad company, pipeline company, water transportation company, and common carrier transporting gasoline, either in interstate or in intrastate commerce, to points within the State, and...to a point in this State from any point outside this State shall report under penalty of purjury, to the Department of Transportation on forms prescribed by the Department, all deliveries of gasoline so made to points within this State."

At present, this section only regulates gasoline. We are requesting that as a minimum, your company also include diesel fuel. Although, we would appreciate if all product shown on Schedule A be reported.

Late filed reports will result in penalties of \$5.00 per day up to a maximum of \$25.00 per report. Reports are due on or before, and must be U.S. postmarked by, the 25th of the calendar month immediately following the month covered by the report.
